

8. On expiry of the period of appointment on contract basis, if the period of contractual appointment is not extended, the appointment shall be deemed automatically terminated.
9. The re-employment of retiring employee shall be made on the same sanctioned post in the cadre on which he/she is at the time of retirement. However, it is restricted upto Dy.Manager cadre of retired Class-'A' officer and Class-'B' Staff depending on optimum operational requirement in such cadre/class.
10. If the performance of a contractual appointee is found un-satisfactory or he/she is found to be indulged in any unfair activities and acting in a manner detrimental to the interest of the Corporation, his/her services on contract basis shall be terminated immediately without giving any notice.
11. The following category of retired employee shall not be eligible for re-employment on contract basis:-
  - (i) Undergoing vigilance enquiry.
  - (ii) Awarded any major punishment
  - (iii) Facing criminal case
  - (iv) Medically unfit.
12. Re-employment of only essentially required retiring/retired officers and staff shall be made. However, re-employment of retired employees shall be made on need basis and a notice to this effect be placed on Web site/notice Board of H.O./B.Os. inviting applications from the employees, when such reappointment of ex-employees is undertaken.
13. The Corporation shall be at liberty to accept or reject the request of its retiring/retired employees for contractual appointment.

This order comes into force with immediate effect.


